Rauch’s vigorous, modern production of Shakespeare’s tragicomedy is a toxic mix of our timeless obsessions—sex, religion and politics.</p> |
| | <p>“Imaginary Invalid” by Moliere. <i>Is there a doctor in the house?</i> The wealthy Argan is a housebound hypochondriac with every disease in the book. Lurking around are quacks only too happy to (mis)treat him. Family troubles, including a money grubbing wife and two headstrong daughters, add to Argan’s miseries. Original songs, satirical bite and the requisite bawdiness. Warning: Excessive laughter may be hazardous to your health.</p> |
